Boxed Lunch

The boxed lunch includes a roasted turkey option with baby greens, cranberry relish, Vermont sharp cheddar, and roasted garlic Dijon, or a vegetarian option with roasted butternut squash, grilled asparagus, maple-whipped ricotta, baby greens, grilled corn, and goat cheese spread. Both are served with a roasted garden vegetable, quinoa and couscous salad, cranberry and white/chocolate chip cookies, and bottled water. Lunches can be picked up and eaten at GCS between the hours of 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.
