You are cordially invited to participate in the *12th annual Groton Community Home Tour*. This is Groton Community School’s (GCS) largest annual fundraising event.

This year’s Home Tour will take place on **Saturday, November 19, 2016** and we have reserved an inclement weather date of Sunday, November 20th.

We have developed two levels of participation for you to select from:

<p>Full Day</p> <p>9-10 AM: Set up 10 - 4 PM: Selling hours 4-5 PM: Clean up</p>	<p>\$90</p> <p>(full payment is required upon sign up to guarantee space)</p>	<p>Package includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Designated area in one of the tour homes (location will be assigned by GCS Board members approximately 2 - 4 weeks prior to the event)

You may also take advantage of an “early bird special.” For all applications **post marked by September 15th**, you may deduct **\$5 from the package cost**, making the Half Day \$55 and a Full Day \$85.

If you would like to participate, please complete the enclosed application and include a check payable to *Groton Community School* **so that we may secure a slot for you**. Please note that payments will only be refunded in the event that GCS is unable to offer you a slot.

Based on the experience of previous year's participants, artisans and vendors with lower price points and easily carried items sell more successfully during the Home Tour. Please keep this in mind when planning the items you will bring on the day of the tour. *It is important to plan accordingly and to note that you should not plan to bring more items than a large table will allow. Please note that slots will be reserved on a first come first served basis, and will be assigned by GCS Board members.*
