If you would like to participate, please complete the enclosed application and include a check payable to *Groton Community School* **so that we may secure a slot for you**. Please note that payments will only be refunded in the event that GCS is unable to offer you a slot.

Based on the experience of previous year's participants, artisans and vendors with lower price points and easily carried items sell more successfully during the Home Tour. Please keep this in mind when planning which items you will bring on the day of the tour. *It is important to plan accordingly and to note that you should not plan to bring more items than a large table will allow. Please note that slots will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis, and will be assigned by GCS Board members.*
