Test & Stay

As we continue to work through the challenges that COVID-19 has brought us, our licensing agency, Early Education and Care, has very recently made some significant changes to help us all move forward. They are putting forth guidelines that will now allow early childhood centers to participate in a "Test and Stay" program when an individual tests positive for COVID-19. This gives families and the down school an alternative to closing the classroom. It does, however, come with risks, adds some inconveniences to drop-off times for families, and also creates some extra responsibilities for the school. After much thought and discussion, GCS has

decided to move ahead and put this program into place. We have filed the necessary paperwork to be able to offer "Test & Stay" and have just received testing kits to implement the program. Please look for updated information on our website soon.
