

# The Groton Community School Scholarship In Memory of Christopher Barton



- 3) A \$500 scholarship will be awarded.
- 4) To be considered, the following materials must be submitted to the GCS Scholarship Committee, 110 Boston Road, Groton, MA 01450 on or before April 30<sup>th</sup>:
  - a. A completed application form.
  - b. An essay describing how the candidate exemplifies the qualities demonstrated by Christopher.
  - c. A letter of reference from a teacher or other mentor.
  - d. A copy of the student's transcript.
  - e. A list of extracurricular and community activities.
