We are extremely honored to receive a \$2,500 grant from the Community

Foundation of North Central Massachusetts. This grant focuses our efforts to "Dig Deeper" into our school wide conservation efforts. With this grant, we have added compost tumblers to reduce waste, rain barrels to minimize town water use, and gardening tools, as well as "Big Dig" excavators and a mud kitchen on order for students to explore and play in our natural environment.

projects, teacher appreciation efforts and more. We couldn't do it without you. Thank you for a wonderful year!


